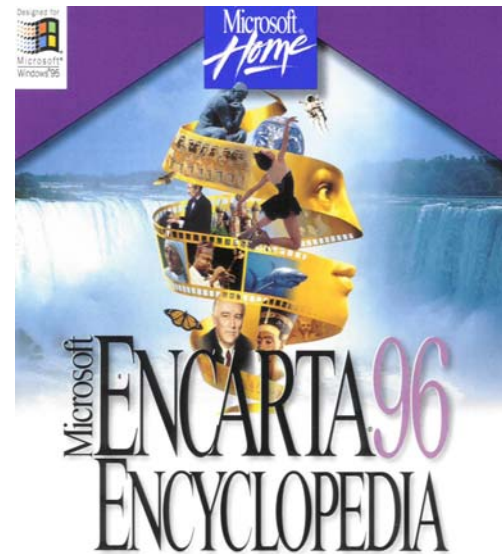

- Etymology: Latin *obsoletus*, from the past participle of *obsolescere* to grow old, become disused, perhaps from *ob-* toward + *solere* to be accustomed

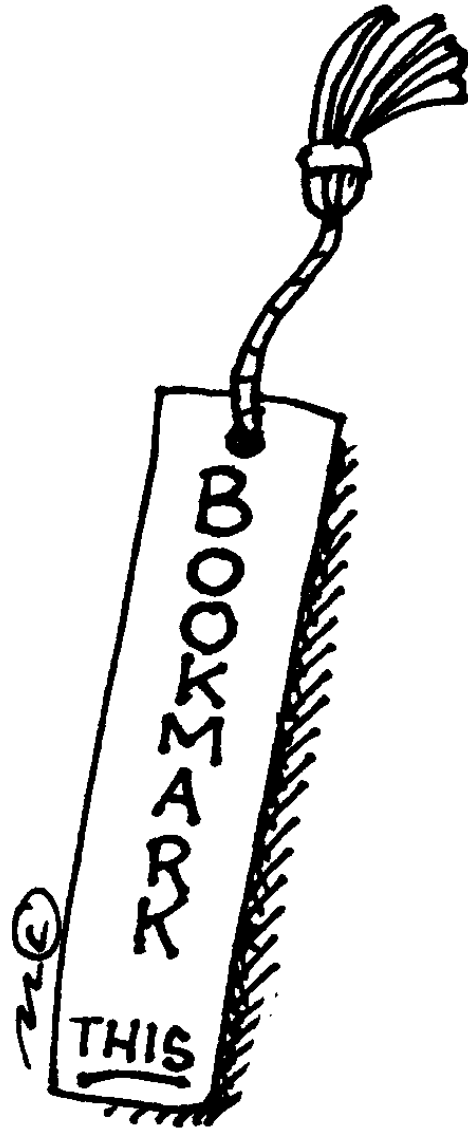
